General Galaxie Vaudeville Camp Procedures.

Room organization

2000 sq ft of class space

Up to 10 'student tables'

Each student will have a table assigned with art supplies and costumes used exclusively by them during the week.

Tables will be rearranged to provide space for classes that require open space such as yoga, tap, juggling, tumbling etc.

All open space classes will require a minimum of 6 ft distance between students, denoted by personal yoga mats brought in by the students.

Open play time will include games that can be done at social distance acceptable spacing, with hand washing before and after. Examples: Jump robe, obstacle courses, table top games, craft projects (individual supplies) additional practice of class material such as juggling, hat tricks tumbling etc.

Rolling tables will be pushed together for lunch periods as represented in the attached diagram, to ensure proper social distancing. Students will be invited to eat at their personal table if they prefer.

Additional precautions

Daily temperature checks for all staff and students.

Each evening the Loft will be thoroughly cleaned and disinfected.

Students will be regularly lined up for hand washing, conducted by adult staff members.

Each evening, plates, glasses and any other specialized class supplies will be laid out to allow for a minimum of 12 hours.

Snacks will be prepared and staged the evening before each day.

Only children from the same family will be invited to sit next to each other for snacks and lunch.
